Dear Dr. Oliver,

I will let you know later, if I can agree to review the paper.

However, are you aware that there were forest fires in Ukraine and Belarus in Summer 1992? Samplers running at Baryshevka and Chernobyl (the town, not the reactor plant) increased by about a factor of two, and were about 10,000 times less than the concentration during the accident. The forest fires were about 20 km from Chernobyl and were in contaminated forests.

My opinion is that data like these are much better than four linked models.
