Screen - Dots in front of screen	25 mins.	
<ul> <li>Direct students to sit on dots and pair with an adult.</li> <li>Introduce van Gogh</li> <li>Show examples of Van Gogh artwork from Arles</li> <li>What do we see in his painting?</li> <li>What colors? How many?</li> <li>Tranisition: Now we are going to use the iPad Ipad Activity: home screen &gt; Play Art app &gt; van Gogh         <ul> <li>Each child creates their own van Gogh sunflowers works in the app</li> <li>End composition, close app, turn off ipad screen</li> </ul> </li> <li>Transition: Let's go to the table and work on our own sunflowers</li> </ul>	Seating dots  Van Gogh  Ppt. Art-making Activity	25 Mins	
Each participant draws a vase and horizon line between table and background with oil pastel.  Use oil pastels to draw flowers, coloring center and petals.  When drawing is completed, use liquid watercolor to paint over the entire drawing, paying attention to different colors for table and background (2 or 3 colors max – too many colors will mix to create a mud color)  Time-permitting, let participants select colors of tissue to glue onto drawing for texture.	Pass out watercolor paper & oil pastels  Pass out sponge brush, and liquid watercolor  Tissue paper to rip; watered down white glue	Volunteers help particpants stay on task and offer ideas from warm-up worksheet.  Volunteers bring water-downed white glue and glue brush to table and help glue tissue pieces
Sharing of artwork & Conc.	10 mins
