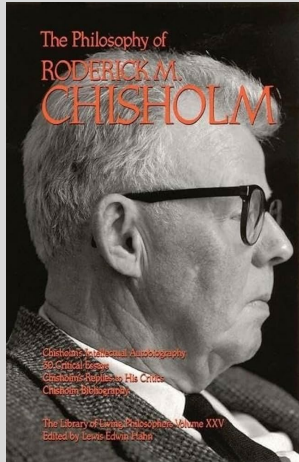


The DEFEAT of Evil
