

Meeting of Yale Golf Committee
100 Broadway, New York City, July 2, 1925 - 10:00 A.M.

Those present: Messrs. George T. Adee, Chairman, M. N. Buckner, J. T. Blossom, George P. Day, George H. Nettleton and H. F. Woodcock.

Voted: To appoint H. F. Woodcock secretary of this committee.

Voted: To adopt the following schedule of membership rates:

1. Patron members of the Ray Tompkins Memorial -
(Patrons to have all the privileges of the 700-acre Memorial and unrestricted use of the Yale Golf Course) \$1000.
2. Life members of the Yale Golf Course
(Use of course restricted in accordance with undergraduate demand)
 - (a) Those living within radius of 20 to 25 miles of Yale Golf Course - distance to be determined after consultation by Mr. Buckner with Rand-McNally Company - 750.
 - (b) Those residing outside said radius 500.
3. Associate members of Yale Golf Course
(Restricted use of course regulated by demand of undergraduates and groups 1 and 2 above)
Initiation fee - 250.
Annual Dues:
 - (a) Those residing within 20-25 mile radius 40.
 - (b) Those living beyond said radius 20.
4. Undergraduates of the College and Sheffield Scientific School and members of Yale Faculty -

Dues from opening of University year to Jan. 1, 1926- 20.
Dues from Jan. 1, 1926 to close of University year 1925-6 20.
Dues for University year 1925-6 35.

Voted: That any classification of membership in the foregoing vote and schedule may be limited in number at the discretion of the Board of Control.

Voted: That in Group No. 1 one transfer of the privileges of the patron will be allowed during his lifetime, (or by the estate)

Voted: That no greens fees are to be charged to members in any of the above classifications.

Voted: That no dues are to be assessed against those in groups 1 and 2.

Voted: That the Chairman appoint a committee to draft form of membership invitation and that the form of invitation be submitted to the other members of the committee for approval.

The Chairman appointed the following committee: Messrs. Nettleton, Blossom and Woodcock.

Voted: That the following names be signed to the invitation: Those present at this meeting and the remaining members of the original golf committee, namely, Messrs. Byers, Gardner and Sweetser.

Voted: To mail membership invitations to all graduates and ex-members of the College and Sheffield Scientific School residing in United States.

Voted: To accept applications for memberships from graduates and ex-members of all departments.

Voted: To release story of course and membership plan in newspapers at time of mailing of invitations and in an early issue of the Alumni Weekly.

Voted: That the Chairman appoint an organization committee, consisting of Messrs. Adee, Blossom and Woodcock, to draft by-laws, after consultation with University council - said committee to submit report and recommendations at next meeting of this committee.

Voted: To authorize members of this committee to invite a total of not over 25 non-Yale men to become patrons - each individual proposed to be unanimously approved by this committee.

Voted: To approve extending an invitation to become a patron to Frederick F. Brewster of New Haven, Conn., proposed by Mr. George P. Day.

Voted: To approve extending invitations to become patrons to Albert R. Fish, George H. Walker and Allen D. Lindley, all of New York City - these names being proposed by Mr. Mortimer N. Buckner.
